Description of Proposed Tree Work(s) :	I have been asked to inspect the trees on the boundary of the property above due to concerns regarding the condition of the trees and the subsequent risk to neighbouring properties.

Observations: ie leaning, crown density, main stem, ivy, deadwood, broken branches, hazardous	On inspection there several trees of concern .There are 2 cherry trees which are leaning towards the neighbouring property and other trees along the boundary with a heavy covering of ivy. None of the trees in question are in a good condition due to dead wood and ivy.
